Guest Visit:



- On 19th Nov, Friends of Forman visited TSA/FCCU. SES students welcomed them with garlands & gifts. The guests were encouraged by our special kids and TSA/FCCU dedicated work for vulnerable women & children.
- On 11th and 17th Dec, total 8 students from Lahore for Women University, visited TSA/FCCU, to play activities with our special kids.

Christmas Celebration:

- On 19th Dec, Sister Mary Rose visited TSA/FCCU. Together with prayer and message, SES students performed beautiful Christmas Carols. Sister Mary Rose & TSA/FCCU distributed Christmas gifts to the students, all students and staff enjoyed a lovely Christmas together.



Needle Crafts Center (NCC)

- During early and mid-Dec, NCC has conducted 3 exhibition, 1 in Salvation Army Head Quarter, 2 in FCCU campus. Christmas season is a seasonal window for NCC product sales, which knitting products and Christmas Decorations are the top selling items during winter. Nevertheless, through this out-reach, we see young students exposed and showed interest in NCC and TSA/FCCU work on empowering vulnerable women and children, which is very encouraging to us.



Physiotherapy Center (PC)

- During Oct-Dec, while continuously providing service to our existing patients (including special children of TSA school & outdoor patients), Mr.Peter initiated a weekly-based technique sharing session within physiotherapy technicians, to enable continuous learning and growing for PC staffs.
- Thanks to the help of FCCU, a need assessment for existing equipment was conducted, the need for more regular PC equipments were identified, also several old equipments were suggested to be replaced, which will arrive in the near future.

Christian Trauma Care and Research Center (CTCRC)

- On 23th Oct, Trauma Healing Event was held in Elsa Peter Hall, TSA/FCCU. The objective of the session was to share experience, identify support mechanism, and explore the role of church in trauma healing. The session was facilitated by Mr. John Douglas and Rev. Susan Ryan, and brought together total 50 participants, including counselors, psychologist, survivors, and community leaders.
- During mid-Dec, Mr. Qadesh (Coordinator, CTCRC) and Rev. Kim (Resource Person, CTCRC) conducted 2 visits to Jaranwala, to prepare for the upcoming IT and sewing class & equipping local Pastors and Sunday School Teachers for children in Jaranwala community in 20-23th Jan, which supported by Korean-American team.



Hostel

- Awareness was conducted for the young girls on their rights, protection and safety. Guest speaker was Dr. Ayra Inderyas.
- On 9th Dec, FCCU-TSA girls hostel celebrated Christmas Party, did carol singing, performed a Christmas skit, and had dinner together. Dr. Uzma also distributed gifts to the staff and their children. Together everyone shared the love of God.



Forman Psychological Service Center (FPSC)

- On 10th Oct, the workshop EMDR (Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing) for trauma-related disorders was held in TSA/FCCU, which facilitated by Dr. Ali Akbar Mansoor, a total 18 participants from different university attended the workshop.
- During Oct-Dec, 9 clients visited FPSC for Individual therapy session.
